

Environment Policy


Birdon operates in close proximity to sensitive environments, including freshwater ecosystems, estuarine areas and marine systems and we recognise that we hold a significant environmental responsibility. Birdon is committed to protecting these systems and the broader environment from pollution and to minimising the environmental impact of our operations.

- Systematically manage the environmental aspects of our operations, through the implementation and maintenance of an environmental management system based on ISO 14001 Standards,

- Comply with legislation, regulations, standards, guidelines, codes of practice and other requirements that apply to the environmental aspects of our operations,
- Establish a set of environmental objectives, targets and committed resources to achieving them, to prevent pollution and to minimise our environmental impact,
- Monitor and review operations regularly to achieve a cycle of continual improvement in our environmental performance, and
- Promote a culture of environmental responsibility.
